# DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

**The Trinity Centre is located within Meole Brace village, and is attached to the north side of Holy Trinity Church.**

**DIRECTIONS FROM MEOLE BRACE ROUNDABOUT** – follow signs towards Town Centre, taking you over a small bridge. Keep left.

Go past the Brooklands Pub, continue about half a mile and turn left at the next roundabout.

Go past the Meole Brace Science College on your left and at the end of their grounds look for a crossroads. Turn left onto Stanley Lane.

Continue along Stanley Lane, over the railway bridge and round the bends until you come to a sharp bend to the left. On the brow of that bend is a right turning onto Church Road.

SATNAV: The postcode for The Trinity Centre is SY3 9HF. On some satnavs, this takes you to the rear gate – if you come to a narrow set of black gates to a long drive which are closed and you can't see the church building, that is what has happened. Turn around and keep bearing left until you reach Church Road.

## **PARKING**

Be alert as you enter Church Road as there is a parking area on the right, just around the first bend. If you are not disabled you should park here – please be confident of creating three rows of cars, with the third row aligned with the yellow hashes at the far end (which should be left empty). You will be able to get out – please park economically to maximise the use of space.

Once parked, continue along Church Road on foot (there is a footpath running parallel – please use this) The Trinity Centre is attached to the north side of Holy Trinity Church which is about 50m along the road on the left.

If the car park is full, please do not park anywhere along Church Road as this creates a very dangerous bottleneck. On-street parking can be found if you turn around (in the car park entrance or in the church gate), go back to the entrance to Church Road, turn left and immediately left again onto Alexandra Avenue.

Limited parking is available in the church grounds, some of which is reserved for disabled people. Please follow the guidelines on the attached leaflet and keep access roads clear for emergencies.

Vehicles may enter the church grounds and block emergency access temporarily for unloading and loading of equipment, but need to be moved afterwards please.
